Statement of Policy

The FIA is the largest fire protection trade association in Europe with 1000+ members. We are a not-for-profit organisation and a major provider of fire safety training.

Our objective is to promote, improve and perfect fire protection & firefighting methods, devices, services, and apparatus. We achieve this through the representation of our members, providing technical support, guidance, and opportunities for professional advancement through education and appropriate regulation.

We are committed to protecting the environment and will continually strive to attain a satisfactory balance between environmental, social and economic responsibilities.

To accomplish this, we will proactively:

- 1. Protect the environment by promoting environmental awareness to industry stakeholders from the design, development and production to the service and distribution of products.
